

#### **Designer Outlet Roermond**

Find your favourite designer brands at up to 70% off, all year round. The beautiful setting close to the centre of Roermond and with cafes and restaurants, children's play area, cheap parking and more than 150 boutiques, there is something for everyone. Opening hours: Monday - Friday: 10am - 8pm Saturday & Sunday: 9am - 8pm The Designer Outlet Roermond is open 363 days a year and closes only on Christmas Day, 25th December, and New Year's Day, 1st January.



#### Maasplassen & Roer 'Cruise'

View the city by boat and go for a boat trip with company Corporal. From June 17 till September 15 you can enjoy a daily cruise at 12:30, 14:00 or 15:30 uur. Duration 70 min. Costs are € 10, - per adult and € 7, - per child. You can board at the Roerkade-Roermond.



#### Cuypershuis

Cuypershuis is the museum about the architect/designer Pierre Cuypers (1827-1921) from Roermond, and makes connections between architecture and contemporary interior design. Cuypershuis is open Tuesday through Sunday from 11am to 4.30pm. The museum is closed on Mondays, and also on January 1st, Carnival Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, the Pentecost, and on December 25th and 26th. Admission prices: Adults € 6,00 Children 7-18 € 4,00.



#### Sint-Christoffelkathedraal

The St Christopher's Cathedral dates back to the year 1410 and is definitely worth a visit! Open daily to visit from 2pm-5pm, except for 1st January and 5th May.
